



Preschool Abeka Curriculum

Our goal is to provide a strong foundation for learning while helping each child grow academically, socially, emotionally, physically, and spiritually.

Phonics and Early Reading

- Recognize and name letters and begin connecting letters with their sounds.
- Develop phonemic awareness through rhyming, beginning sounds, and listening activities.
- Recognize and practice basic letter sounds.
- Begin blending sounds and recognizing simple words as developmentally ready.
- Listen to and discuss stories, poems, and books.
- Build vocabulary and develop a love for reading.

Goal: Build the early literacy skills needed for successful reading instruction in Kindergarten.

HANDWRITING & WRITING READINESS

- Develop proper pencil grip and control.
- Trace and practice basic lines, shapes, letters, and numbers.
- Recognize and practice writing their name.
- Develop fine-motor skills through coloring, cutting, tracing, drawing, and other hands-on activities.
- Begin forming letters and numbers correctly as developmentally ready.

Goal: Develop the fine-motor control and writing readiness needed for Kindergarten.

Numbers and Math

- Recognize, count, and write numbers at an age-appropriate level.
- Count objects and understand basic number quantities.
- Recognize basic shapes, colors, patterns, and sizes.
- Compare objects using concepts such as more/less, big/small, and same/different.
- Explore basic addition and subtraction concepts through hands-on activities.
- Develop one-to-one counting and number recognition.

Goal: Build a strong foundation in number sense, counting, patterns, shapes, and mathematical thinking.

Science

- God's Creation: The world around us, nature, weather, seasons, and God's wonderful creation.
- Living Things: Plants, animals, insects, and what living things need to grow.
- Exploring Our World: The five senses, basic observations, and simple science concepts through hands-on activities.

Goal: Encourage curiosity and help children discover and appreciate the world God created.

SOCIAL STUDIES & COMMUNITY

- Families, friends, classrooms, and communities.
- Community helpers and their roles.
- Classroom rules, routines, and responsibilities.
- Basic safety and appropriate social behaviors.
- Holidays, traditions, and important people and events.
- The world around us and how people live and work together.

Goal: Help children understand their place in their family, classroom, community, and world.

Bible

- That God created the world and loves each of us.
- Simple Bible stories and important biblical truths.
- Stories about Jesus and His love for us.
- Bible verses through age-appropriate memorization.
- The importance of prayer, kindness, obedience, honesty, and helping others.
- How to show God's love through everyday actions.

Goal: Build an early foundation of biblical knowledge, faith, and Christian character.
